

Baseball/Softball Field Facility Rental Rules & Regulations

AUHSD operates with limited resources in maintaining the baseball and softball fields during the schools off season. Use of this facility by outside users will require some field prep work from the facility renters.

- No stakes or any items that puncture the ground may be used on any field at any time.
- Tarps - Please fold them neatly before carrying them off the playing field. Use several players/coaches to avoid dragging them.
 - Please do not leave tarps on the grass.
 - Always apply tarps at the completion of the game.
- Use only (dirt) areas to conduct infield practices. Please do not allow players to take practice swings on grass areas.
- Raking - Rake away from the grass. Please do not rake (dirt) into the grass. This includes muddy water being raked and dragged out of low spots after rainfall.
- Rake an approximately ten-foot diameter circle around bases and pitcher's mounds after each practice and game.
 - Level off and tamp down the low spots as best you can with the rake.
 - Rake out home plate area, leveling out and tamping down batter's boxes and catcher's position.
- Rake bullpens when practice or games are complete to prevent water from puddling up in the low spots.
- Do not allow players or kids to rake fields – coaches and/or parents only, please.
- Please do not shut off or make any adjustments to irrigation valves.
- Pick up trash in dugouts.
- Mother Nature - Rain, Lightening, Dry Dust Bowl Powder; can create difficult field management conditions; we understand, do the best you can to manage. Be SAFE!
- Do not take any soft toss against field fencing.
- Do not take batting practice against the fence directly behind Home Plate.
 - No balls should be thrown directly against the home plate fence.
- Do not rake or add field dirt to the mounds; tarp these mounds after your game/practice.
- Batters & catchers boxes - Simply tarp.
- Batting Cages are not available for use.
