Testing

SAT/PSAT

- Friday, 10/18 - School Day PSAT. Open to all 10th and 11th graders. Cost is \$30, sign up on AHS Webstore. Deadline is Monday, 9/9.
- Wednesday, 3/3/25 - School Day SAT for Juniors only. Sign up through Webstore when available. Cost around \$60.
- Saturday SAT test dates are available through CollegeBoard.org.

ACT

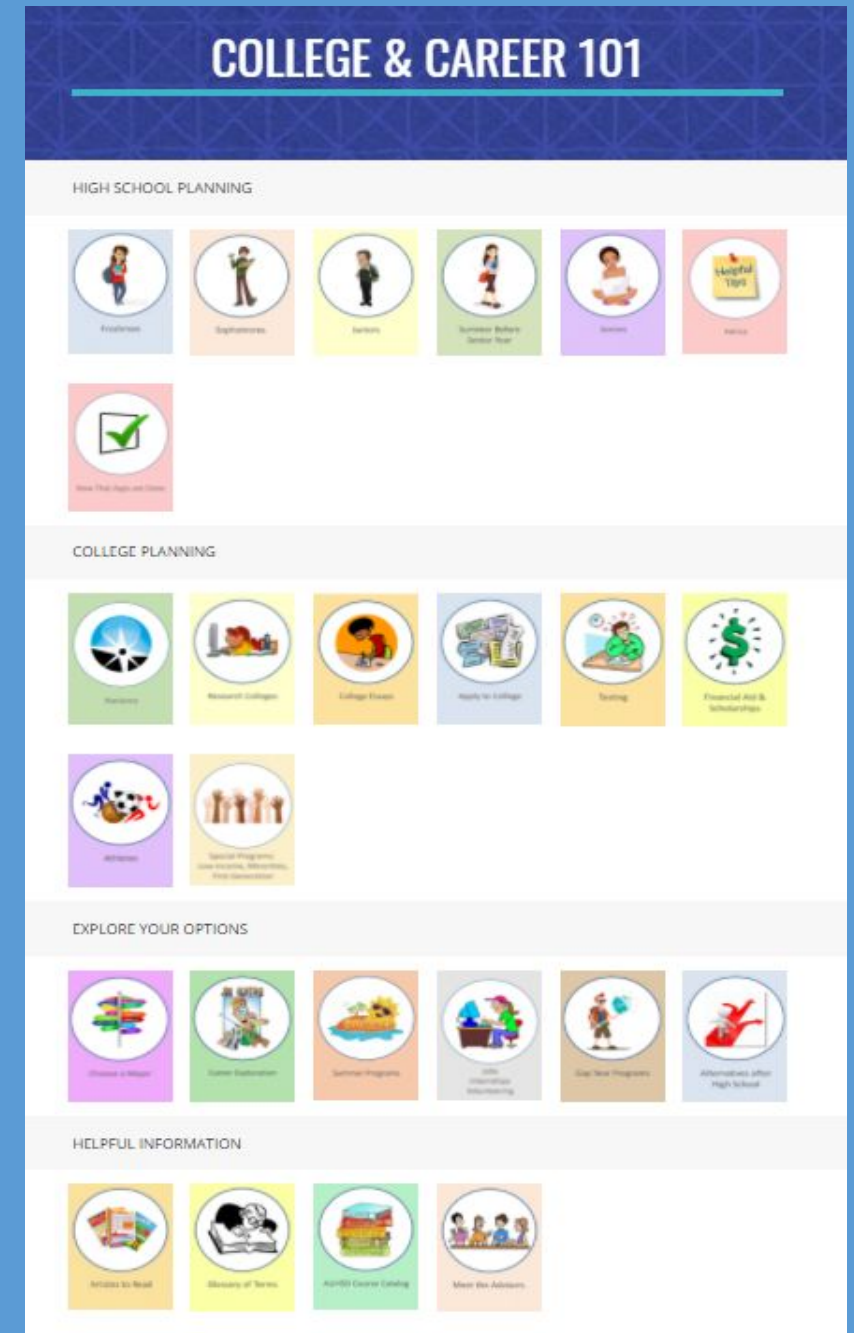
- Not offered at AHS, but various dates available. Sign up through act.org.

AP Testing - May 5-16, 2025

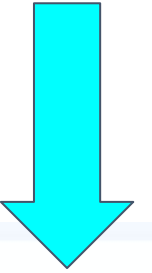
- Sign up through Webstore by 11/8. Cost is \$110 per exam. Get a “Join Code” from your teacher (specific to your period), enter code on CollegeBoard.org.
- If taking a test and not the class, come to Counseling for “Join Code”.
- You must pay for exam AND enter Join Code to complete sign up for tests.
- Deadline to sign up for all AP tests is 11/8!

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
